Further, a xeri-scaping approach has been mandated whereby natural grasses, wildflowers and topography are incorporated. Construction methodology encourages the use of natural, sustainable products such as locally harvested stone, timber and wood materials, and high efficiency windows, doors and in-floor radiant heating products. The result is a gorgeous alpine community of homes that not only look good, but that live well, too.
