- i. Hike or bike the ski hill or any of the extensive trails through [Kimberley's 2000 acre nature park](#). Here you will find a trail for riders of all age and abilities. Every Wednesday evening meet at the Overwaitea parking lot at 6:30 pm and join locals for a group ride through the trails --all levels are welcome!
- ii. Kimberley is home to a pretty cool [Skateboard & BMX bike park](#). You can find the Kimberley Skatepark at the corner of Marsden Street and Rotary Drive, just south of downtown by the bridge. We recommend the skaters and bikers in the family bring their helmets and body gear - this park offers some steep bowls and big air opportunities.
- iii. If skateboarding and bike trails are not your speed, visit [Cominco Gardens](#) for a peaceful stroll. These gardens were established in 1927, cover 5 hectares of land and are home to more than 45,000 blooms. Cominco Gardens can be found up in the Townsite District, across the valley from the Kimberley Alpine Resort and **DreamCatcher**.
- iv. Every Sunday morning from 9am-1pm walk through the [Kimberley Village Farmers Market](#) at the Platzl. Not a morning person? No problem, from August 7th through 9th, Kimberley's Platzl will be home to the annual "[Arts on the Edge](#)" featuring free concerts all weekend and an evening lantern parade at 10pm on opening night.
- v. Looking for some water? Grab your favourite beach read and head to [Wasa Lake Provincial Park](#). It's a quick 20 minute drive to the north. Alternatively, bring your kayak or fishing gear and hit the St. Mary's river just a short jaunt south. It is known locally for great [Fly Fishing](#) and whether you're looking for a quiet paddle through the valley or a rodeo ride in some fast moving white water, the St. Mary's river is sure to pr
